Exhibition and Catalogue

The final presentation of the project will be a full-scale exhibition at WATERMANS ARTS CENTRE in London, at the CINEMA HOUSE in SOFIA and at the HAUS der KULTUREN der WELT (HKW) in Berlin. An exhibition in Barcelona in close co-operation with the CENTRE de CULTURA CONTEMPORANIA de BARCELONA (CCCB) is also envisaged.

Installation work, graphics, and interactive multi-media activities will be presented together with a catalogue.
